MANAGEMENT IN THE 21ST CENTURY - ISSUES, CHALLENGES AND THE ROAD AHEAD

The Department of MBA organized the 2nd International Conference with the theme 'Management in the 21st Century – Issues, Challenges and the Road Ahead'.



The Conference received more than 75 papers from seven different countries. The event was inaugurated on 21st March 2016 at 9:30 AM in the Arthur Shenoi Memorial Auditorium, at Aloysius Institute of Management and Information Technology (AIMIT). Delegates from various parts of India as well as international delegates participated in the deliberations. The Conference saw participation from countries like Canada, Australia, Malaysia, the Middle East and Tanzania. The chief guest for the inaugural function was Mr. Allen C A Pereira, formerly the executive director of Oriental Bank of Commerce, and the Chairman and Managing Director (CMD) of Bank of Maharashtra. The keynote address was delivered by Mr. Allen Pereira wherein he mentioned that this century is going to be critical one for India. The mantra which he wanted individuals to follow was think global and act local. He even cited that employee engagement and leadership are key areas which have to be focused in order to have a better future along with understanding global management.

Rev. Fr Dr. Oswald Mascarenhas delivered a bird's eye view of the Conference theme wherein he focused more on the two pillars supporting the corporation that is the debt and equity. He intimated that corporations enjoy most of the rights and responsibilities that an individual possesses and so the ethical aspect is an important aspect which has to be taken care of. The dignitaries formally released both the Proceedings of the Conference and the March 2016 issue of the Aloysius journal of Management and Research.

The day long deliberations saw more than 75 research papers being presented by delegates in four parallel sessions with relevant comments and suggestions from both co delegates and the session chair.

RIGHT TO WORK: NEW DIMENSIONS OF DISTRESS

On March 08, 2016, The Department of Economics, St Aloysius College, Mangaluru in collaboration with Indian Social Institute, Bengaluru organized a one day National Workshop on Right to Work: New Dimensions of Distress Migration in South India. The chief guest and inaugurator of the Workshop Shri Hemacharya, Chief editor, Daijiworld weekly gave a bird's eye view of distress migration. He spoke about the 3Ms i.e Mangaloreans, Malayalis and Madarasi to be the highest number in migration. He said that migrants are adventurous. He also said that we should interact with the migrants and treat them with dignity. It is because they are used for the work in the place of destination and it is our moral duty to give them respect and a dignified life. Rev. Fr Swebert D'Silva SJ the Principal of the College presided over the function.



Rev Fr Martin Puthusherry SJ from the Indian Social Institute made a wonderful presentation in which he clearly dealt with the problems of marginalized section of the society going for distress migration and the challenges ahead. Dr Vinoj Abraham, Associate Professor at Centre for Development Studies dealt with the labour market for distress migrants, its emergence and its features. He highlighted the fact that large scale of migrant population from the northern states migrate to south India especially in search of employment in menial jobs.

Dr Shaukath Azim, Professor of the Department of Sociology, Karnataka University, Dharwad said that it is the juggernaut, the force which is responsible for migration. He also highlighted on the stages of migration and the changes in demographic profile especially in rural areas. Dr Sajikumar S, Fellow, New India Foundation, New Delhi focused on the insecurities and vulnerabilities of interstate migrant workers.

Around 172 delegates participated in the Workshop. Paper presentation by teachers and students was an added attraction of the Workshop.

INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO KMF

As a part of our curriculum, Twenty two students of MSc Food Science and Technology along with two faculty members Dr Mamatha and Ms Feby, visited Karnataka Cooperative Milk Producers' Federation Limited (KMF), the milk processing and distributing industry in Mangaluru (An ISO -22000- 2005 certified organization) on 19th march 2016. KMF is a young industry, founded in the year 1986 as a cooperative society. Now the Union is pro-curing 3,35,742 KPD through 671 Dairy Cooperative Societies.

Mr. Manoj was the guide who explained about the equipments involved in milk processing such as pasteurizer, homogenizer, cream separator, steam jacketed kettle, plate heat exchanger, cooler, refrigerated tank etc. He guided us to different milk product processing units such as the receiving process, pasteurization, homogenization, packaging unit etc. Milk received is examined



through rapid platform test i.e., clot on boiling, lactometer test, fat test, microbial analysis and goes to the next process of sterilisation. Based on the percentage fat content four varieties of milk is manufactured here i.e. toned milk, homogenized milk, *shubam* and *samridhi*. He explained to the processed milk products such as Peda, Mysore pak, Paneer nandini bite, lassi, curd, flavoured milk, kaju barfi etc. A complimentary drink of Lassi and butter milk was provided to all of us. The Industrial visit was informative and it helped us to understand the working of an industry.



NCAT EXAMS

International Forum for Excellence in Higher Education (IFEHE) conducts NCAT (National Creativity Aptitude Tests) Exams every year for students of engineering, management and science streams in institutes of higher education enrolled in graduate and post-graduate courses. The NCAT 2016 was the 5th version of the test. There will be separate tests for the students of different categories, in which student's creative thinking and logical reasoning abilities will be tested. The test will be conducted in two phases. **Round 1** will be conducted at the college end and two top performing students of each category from each college from round 1 will qualify for the next round of Test. **Round 2** will be conducted at Delhi (New Delhi). Apart from MCQs there will be subjective questions on creativity and an activity to assess the achievement motivation of the student.

Our students from MCA and MSc(ST) took the NCAT exams here at AIMIT on 22nd February 2016. Out of 180 students 4 students have qualified for Round 2 which will be held on 29-May-2016 at Bangalore and 12-Jun-2016 at New Delhi.
