

## National Workshop on Instrumental Techniques, Maintenance and Servicing of Analytical and Laboratory Instruments

**D**U KAUSHAL KENDRA, St Aloysius College (Autonomous) Mangalore had organized a national workshop on Instrumental techniques, maintenance and servicing of analytical and laboratory instruments in association with Western Regional Instrumentation Centre, Mumbai. This three day workshop was held



from 19<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> January 2017.

The occasion was graced by the honorable chief guest Mr. N N Rao (technical officer of WRIC), Principal Rev. Fr Swebert D'Silva SJ, Director and Vice Principal of LCRI Rev. Dr Praveen Martis SJ, Director of Star College Scheme Dr Ronald Nazareth and the Vice Principal of Xavier block Mr John Sherra.

The program commenced by a pleasant reception by Rev. Dr Praveen Martis SJ followed by the lighting of the lamp by the dignitaries.

The guest of honor Mr N N Rao addressed the gathering by giving away his valuable speech on the need and importance of technical knowledge and methodologies, requirements and precautions regarding handling of high end equipment.

The principal Rev. Fr Swebert D'Silva SJ conveyed his views based on education system stating that knowledge, skill and attitude are the three important ingredients for a successful education system. The formal ceremony was finally concluded by Mr Ajith by proposing the vote of thanks.

The workshop session on 19<sup>th</sup> January 2017 began with a theory class based on principle and working of the instruments. The scholars had enlightened the students both in theory and in practical ways to reflect philosophically on technical ideas.

The students were divided into three batches and were sent to electronics lab, electrical lab and biotechnology lab. The electronics lab was headed by Mr. Sudeer whose explanation was based on multimeter and the method of operation, switch thermostat, carbon brush, fuse, heating coil of two types, indicator, regulator and complete knowledge of various different parts of the instruments.

The biotechnology lab was headed by Mr Milind who dealt with microscope, its theory and the method to clean and rectify each part.

The electrical lab was lead by Mr Devendre Gunde followed by Mr N N Rao. He focused on instruments like calorimeter, spectrophotometer, pH meter and explained the concept and principle behind its working.

On 21<sup>st</sup> January 2017, the workshop got concluded with the valedictory programme with Rev. Dr Praveen Martis SJ as the president of the programme. The occasion was further graced by the most eminent personality Mr N N Rao, Director of Star College Scheme Dr. Ronald Nazareth.

## Workshop on Bio Informatics and Computational Biology

A five day workshop on '**Bioinformatics and Computational Biology**' was conducted from 9<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> Jan, 2017 by St Aloysius Institute of Management and Information Technology (AIMIT), St Aloysius College, Centre for Bioinformatics, supported by the Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India. It started with a prayer session. The inaugural program was attended by Mr Santhosh Rebello, Ms Hemalatha N, participants and bioinformatics students. Program was inaugurated by Mr Santhosh Rebello in which he enlightened the participants with scope of Bioinformatics and its present boom. The aim of the workshop was acquainting students with various bioinformatics tools by providing hands on training on the same. Participants for the workshop consisted of MSc Biotechnology students from the main college.

The first day of the program was handled by Ms Hemalatha N, coordinator of Bioinformatics. She handled the session on Introduction and scope of the subject. An introduction to Database was covered by Kavyashri, MSc bioinformatics 2<sup>nd</sup> year student. After noon lab session was given in which a demo was presented and later students were given exercise of the same.

Second day session started with lab exercise followed by a session on sequence alignment and sequence similarity search tools by Ms Hemalatha. In the afternoon, hands on session were given on BLAST, FASTA and sequence alignment tools.

Multiple Sequence Alignment and Gene prediction programs was handled by Miss Kavyashri on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day. The second forenoon session was handled by guest lecturer Mr Shine P Varkey on Homology Modeling. A lab session was conducted in the afternoon by Ms Vanitha P on statistics tools.



Fourth day was taken by Mr Shine P Varkey on Drug Designing. Lab session on Proteomics was demonstrated in the second forenoon session followed by lab session on homology modeling and gene prediction programs.

On the last day, a one hour session on Big data in Bioinformatics was handled by MSc bioinformatics student, Jithin P Jose. Second forenoon was handled by Mr Santhosh Rebello on future aspects of job and various project prospects. Finally afternoon session had lab on drug designing and students were asked to attempt an MCQ's covering the topic for 5 days.

The program ended with a valedictory session where the participants were given the opportunity to share their experiments of the workshop. Participants were given away the certificates by Mr Santhosh Rebello, Dean of IT and Bioinformatics.

## Rural Immersion Programme

**F**rom JANUARY 12 to 18, 2017, the Department of MBA provided us with a beautiful experience called Rural immersion programme in remote villages of Mundgod and Hanagal. This event brought in us curiosity, thrill, excitement and sense of solidarity with the poor, neglected and less cared for. We, the students of MBA department were fortunate to stay with the poor and learn much from them. We experienced their genuine love, positive attitude towards life, commitment towards their family and compassionate gesture to the strangers.

When corporate teaches us to ignore the poor and unprofitable, these poor people taught us to embrace the unwanted. They taught us what is life all about. They are poor not by option but the corporate has made them to be so in economic terms. They are denied basic facilities by government. The rich and the powerful exploit them. They are rich in many ways. They are rich in hospitality, concern towards others and in sharing whatever they have. They are ready to sacrifice to take care of strangers. They may not have ornaments or jewellery to wear but their smile, helping nature, concern are the permanent jewels that they wear everyday.



Prajwal Bhakta would describe his experience as “.....those were really a beautiful days in my life, on my last day in the rural camp, I really didn’t want to leave that village and come back to Mangaluru, this was just because of the love that I received from the people, the hospitality that they provided, the food that they served every time when we visited their homes, the cooperation they gave, made me never look back and spend some more time in village with them”.

Rachel Stanley describes her experience as “.....the care and concern we received was pure. They genuinely kept a check on us to see if we felt at home. The people in the village are very hardworking. The common issue we came across was that, on an average, 30%-35% of the inherits were unemployed or rather unaware of the employment opportunities in and around the village as they lack a lot of relevant data and information about new opportunities, reforms, policies and schemes. Sad truth is that, women are still dominated by men, to keep it simple, they live in a male dominated environment.

Adopt a village? NO! Adopt a family? May be! Adopt one child each to educate? Yes!

That’s exactly what my team decided because education is one thing which can turn negative vibes into positive vibes and bad into good and Education can make a difference in the society”

Sandria Rodrigues shares her experience as “...We were welcomed warmly by the villagers. The great hospitality shown by the people, their love and affection made us feel that we were one among them. We learnt a lot by interacting with them. We got to know the culture and traditions of the village by attending their



Sankranti festival. Though they do not have enough money to fulfil their needs they are happy in their life. This is an important thing they taught us in those four days. Sometimes the smallest things take up the most space in our heart this rural camp is one such experience. I am grateful to AIMIT”.

It is clear that all the students enjoyed their rural immersion programme and as they prepare for their future jobs they have a soft corner for the poor. Jesuit education has taught them not only to get information but to have an integrated formation so that they transform themselves and the society they live in.

## Talk on Good Manufacturing Practices



On January 10, 2017 the staff of B.Voc Pharmaceutical Chemistry, under the guidance of Rev. Dr Praveen Martis SJ organized a talk on 'Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP)' was delivered by Dr K.V Udupa.

Rabayathul Adabiya, student of first year B.Voc pharmaceutical Chemistry welcomed the resource person and the gathering. Dr K.V. Udupa was florally welcomed by Dr Adarsha Gowda.

Dr K.V. Udupa brings with him rich experience of two and a half Decades in Research and Development, Manufacturing, Marketing and Leadership development. He has worked in reputed Pharma companies in Private, Public and Multinational sectors. Prior to joining Arkgen Pharma Pvt Ltd, he worked in Sequent Scientific Ltd. He holds Ph.D and Masters Degree in Organic Chemistry from Mangalore University and Post Doctoral research experience from Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore.

The talk began at 2pm stating 'Chemistry in our community is nothing but chemical science everywhere'. He also spoke about the different ages of sciences. He then proceeded with his views on pharmaceutical industry, its different sectors and major pharmaceutical companies.



He continued his talk on drugs v\s consumer goods services and briefed with the definition, classification as well as types of drugs. He also spoke on API, guidelines of GMP, regulatory agencies setup world wide, what GMP reveals, the quality choices, general considerations and four M's for quality manufacturing which finally yields quality product.

Further he spoke about Pharmaceutical factory location, importance and factors responsible for the plant location choices, process equipments, quality and contamination of water, personal hygiene and health and the disciplinary acts that has to be followed by Pharma industry.

The resource person finally concluded his talk stating that 'Pharmaceutical industry must produce high quality products with no risks'.

This talk enriched our knowledge on GMP. The various facts and criteria's followed by Pharmaceutical industry was brought into light. This knowledge gained by the students will surely give them the opportunity to make a difference.

## Orientation for MCA II Sem Students
