WORKSHOP ON NGS DATA ANALYSIS

A five day workshop on “NGS Data Analysis” was organized from 12th Mar to 16th Mar' 2018 by St Aloysius Institute of Management and Information Technology (AIMIT), St. Aloysius College, Centre for Bioinformatics in collaboration with ICAR – Central Plantation Crop Research Institute, Kasargod supported by the Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India. The workshop was coordinated by Dr M K Rajesh from CPCRI and Dr Hemalatha N from AIMIT.

The aim of the workshop was to equip the participants with essential informatics, skill and knowledge required to begin analyzing Next Generation Sequencing data and carry out some of the most common types of analysis. 24 students from different states which included faculties, PhD scholars, Post Doc researchers and PG students from our department participated in the workshop.

5 days programme was inaugurated at CPCRI, Kasargod on 12th Mar'2018. Dr. TS Keshava Prasad from Yenepoya University was the Chief guest for the Programme. CPCRI director Dr Chowdappa presided over the programme and Rev Fr Denzil Lobo SJ gave felicitation. Post tea session was handled by Dr. TS Keshava Prasad on the topic “Multi-Omics Approaches for Accurate Assembly and Annotation of Genomes”. 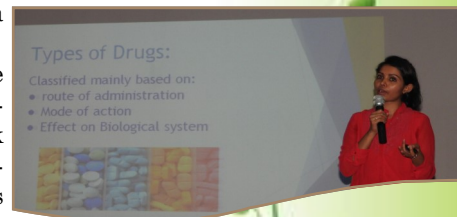

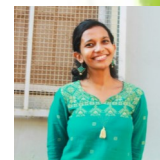

Student says she was moral policed by cops

DURING a programme held in Aloysius College on Wednesday on transforming fear into hope, a student of a city-based college recounted an incident wherein the police terrorised her for socialising with a boy from another community.

The victim, who works at an organisation that spreads menstruation awareness among students was with her male friend from the same organisation discussing work at Sultan Battery, when they came across two school girls being badgered with questions by policemen there for being with two older boys. Despite interfering in the situation that had already caught many eyeballs, the cops apparently continued raising

their voice, asking the girls their names.

While the girls clung to the victim hoping for relief, she assured them of help and asked the police to lower their voice and call a female police officer, which apparently did not go down well with them. An onlooker threatened the girls of clicking their picture and posting it on social media to shame them in public forum, said the victim.

In a while, a police jeep arrived with a lady officer to take the girls. The victim and her friend accompanied them. However, when they reached the station, the victim was asked why she was at Sultan Battery with another boy. After enquiring their names and address, a cop reportedly asked them what a Hindu and Muslim were doing together.

He then wanted our parents' number. She tried explaining to him about the reason she was at the station, where the girls were being wrongly questioned by a personnel from his station and accompanied the girls who were too scared.

Meanwhile, the man who threatened to publish the girls' pictures in social media hit the victim's friend, asking him to give his address and phone number to cops.

As the surroundings seemed hostile, the victim called her mother and explained to the cop about the reason she was there, and told him, "You are the one that should be protecting us." His reply was sarcastic, she said.

A written complaint was given to police commissioner T R Suresh but no action has been taken, she said.

'Konkani Thesar' released

MANGALURU: Fr Prashanth Matha SJ, former principal of St Aloysius College, has said that a language grows only when it borrows words from other languages and one should not shy away from using words of other languages, especially when speaking our vernacular language.

He was speaking during the release of his Konkani book 'Konkani Thesar', a compilation of Konkani synonyms, at St Aloysius College.

Fr Matha said that a language, like English, has grown leaps and bounds mainly due to its craving for vocabulary, which it borrows liberally from all possible languages.

"The era of purity in the usage of a language is gone. When we do not help a language by strengthening its

vocabulary, the language dies and it is here that all speakers of native languages have a role to play, in that they must not worry about speaking a 'shudhi' (pure) language, rather they must at least attempt to speak the language, even if it is a 'krichidi' (mixture) of several languages," he added.

Elaborating on how language becomes a status symbol, Fr Matha said that while a foreign language, like English, gets an elite status in India, native languages are looked down upon and are at times given a low status, he said.

"When the maid tries to speak in English, her boss (the housewife) will invariably reply, 'oh in the native language. This is because the so-

called English speakers have a condescending attitude and think that conversing in English with the native speakers would equal their status," he remarked.

Dr Anil Pinto, Registrar of Christ (Deemed to be University), Bengaluru, gave an introduction to Fr Matha's book.

He said that the book has more advanced classifications than that of Roger's Thesarus. "It is indeed a matter of great pride for Konkani people that the language now has its own thesaurus. Many scheduled languages in India are yet to bring out a thesaurus," he said.
